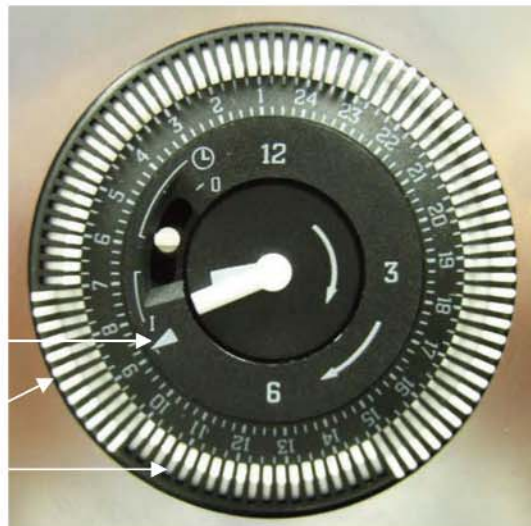

Remeha Single channel Mechanical time clock



Time of day and switching point

Switching tappets - ON

Switching tappets - OFF

For use with the Avanta Plus Combi range

The time clock is a 230v single channel unit which can be mounted inside the boiler to time control the operation of the heating system (the domestic hot water is permanently available upon demand and will always take priority over central heating).

The time clock is set using the 24 hour principle, and has ON/OFF tappets adjustable to 15 minute switching intervals to provide heating periods to suit occupancy needs. A manual override switch can be used to turn the heating ON or OFF permanently

Manual override

Selector to 0 - Permanently OFF

Selector to Clock symbol Timed
(as shown)

Selector to I - Permanently ON



Time of day arrowhead

Time of Day Setting

Using outer ring rotate clockwise until the time of day is set (using a 24hour clock) opposite the time of day arrow head (Illustration shows Time of Day set to approx 0845)

Setting Heating ON / OFF Times

To set the ON Periods push the tappets to the outer position

To set the OFF Periods push the tappets to the inner position

Illustration shows :

First period ON at 0700 - OFF at 1000

Second period ON at 1445 - OFF at 2300
